(b) Issue

Request of M/s Infosys Ltd., Developer of Infosys IT/ITES SEZ, Super Corridor, Indore for construction of security block, car parking and play court as part of authorized operations in the processing area – Filing of list of material for approval of UAC:-

M/s Infosys Ltd., Developer of IT/ITES SEZs at Super Corridor, Indore has submitted the captioned request stating that they propose to construct security block in SEZ area having total built-up area of 349.98 sq.mtr. and car parking and play court having total built-up area of 7500 sq.mtr. as part of their authorized operations in the processing area.

The Developer has submitted a separate list of material for each of the above proposed activity duly certified by the Chartered Engineer, M/s D.S. Parihar & Associates, Indore along with a certificate regarding the correctness of the list(s) of material. All

the materials for the afore-stated activities would be procured domestically.

Rule 12 of the SEZ Rules, 2006 stipulates that the developer may import or procure goods and services from the DTA without payment of duty, taxes and cess for the authorized operations, subject to the provisions contained in the sub rules (2) to (8). Rule 12 (2), further states that the developer shall make an application, after obtaining approval for the authorized operations under rule 9, to the Development Commissioner along with the list of goods and services, including machinery, equipments and construction materials required for the authorized operations, duly certified by a Chartered Engineer for approval by the Approval Committee. The approval under Rule 9 is to be taken from the BoA.

The Deptt. of Commerce has issued Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 circulating therein, a consolidated list of default authorized operations, which can be undertaken by the Developer/Co-Developer by default from the date of Notification. That is, for any activity not covered in the default list, a separate application under Rule 9 has to be made by the Developer to the BoA. According to the Instruction, the DCs / UACs may allow Developer/approved Co-Developers duty free goods and services for these default authorized operations from the date of Notification of the SEZ. These authorized operations will, however, continue to be subject to the various guidelines issued from Govt. from time to time. UACs while approving goods and services for such default operations may look into the actual requirements of the SEZ for such operations. As per the consolidated list, the activity of construction of security block, play court and car parking are listed at S.No. 11, 14 & 18 in the Annexure to Instruction No. 50 and therefore, the activities proposed falls within the permitted default authorized operations. Further, as per Instruction No. 54 dated 30.04.2010, construction of all types of building in processing area is allowed with the approval of UAC.

While submitting the list of materials to be procured, the Developer had requested for procurement of sand and red soil from DTA, which are restricted items under ITC(HS) Code 25051011 in the Export Policy. As per the provisions of fourth proviso to Rule 27(1) of SEZ Rules 2006, the procurement of restricted items from DTA shall be subject to prior approval of the Board of Approval. In the present Covid-19 circumstances, the Deptt. of Commerce has informed that in order to facilitate the stakeholders during the current lockdown situation in the country, it is decided to delegate the powers to the Development

	Commissioner to allow procurement of sand and soil from DTA for construction activities, subject to the following conditions:-
	 (i) Items allowed are actually used by the unit only. (ii) Fulfillment of safeguards and Standard Operating Procedures imposed by MHA. (iii) Environmental obligations prescribed by the MoEF & CC/State Pollution Control Board are met; and (iv) Post ratification by BoA, whenever the next meeting is convened.
	The above was intimated to the Developer and in response, the Developer vide letter dated 04.08.2020 informed that for the procurement of restricted items i.e. sand and red soil, royalty will be payable as per the standard process to Mineral Resources Department, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh hence, the same need not be considered as part of list of material.
	The Developer has therefore submitted a revised list of materials towards construction of security block, car parking and play court duly certified by the Chartered Engineer wherein, the items sand and red soil have been excluded.
	With regard to the undertakings, following have been submitted:-
	 (i) Undertaking to the effect that the items requested for procurement from DTA will be used by the Developer; (ii) Undertaking to the effect that the Developer will fulfill as per standard operating procedures imposed by MHA; and (iii) Undertaking to the effect that the environmental obligations prescribed by MoEF and State Pollution Control Board will be fulfilled.
	The Developer has therefore requested to consider the revised list of materials along with declaration/documents for approval.
	The proposal is accordingly placed before the Approval Committee for consideration.
