(b) Issue	Submission of 2 nd additional list of material required for various types of Interior work, Networking and Landscaping work at M/s Yash Technologies Pvt. Ltd. SEZ under Rule 12 of SEZ Rules 2006:-
	M/s Yash Technologies Pvt. Ltd. has been granted formal approval dated 04.07.2019 for setting up of sector specific IT/ITES SEZ on Plot No. 1 (part), scheme No. 166, Indore. The SEZ has been notified vide Notification dated 05.08.2019 over an area of 2.746 hectares which has been declared as processing area. As per records, the SEZ has operationalized w.e.f 02.07.2022.
	The Developer vide letter dated 08.09.2022 has submitted a 2 nd additional list of goods/material to be procured by them for developing infrastructure i.e. Interior work, Networking and

Landscaping work and other Electric Installation in the building for development of the SEZ premises and to keep the premises ready for SEZ units, duly certified by the Chartered Engineer, for approval by the Approval Committee under the provisions of Rule 12 of SEZ Rules 2006. A Chartered Engineer certificate issued by Sunil Garg, Govt. Regd. Valuer & Chartered Engineer, Indore,

certifying the requirement of the additional goods/materials to carry on the above authorized operations over an area admeasuring 19,405.01 sq. mtrs. having the total material value (indigenous requirement) as Rs. 15,34,43,074.52/- has been enclosed. The summary of goods required for the authorized operations is as under:

Rule 12 of the SEZ Rules, 2006 stipulates that the Developer may import or procure goods and services from the DTA without payment of duty, taxes and cess for the authorized operations, subject to the provisions contained in the sub rules (2) to (8). Rule 12 (2), further states that the Developer shall make an application, after obtaining approval for the authorized operations under Rule 9to the Development Commissioner along with the list of goods and services, including machinery, equipments and construction materials required for the authorized operations, duly certified by a Chartered Engineer for approval by the Approval Committee.

Further, Rule 10 of SEZ Rules, 2006 provides that the Approval Committee may permit goods and services to carry on the authorized operations under Rule 9.

The Deptt. of Commerce has issued Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 and Instruction No. 54 dated 30.04.2010 circulating therein, a consolidated list of default authorized operations, which can be undertaken by the Developer/Co-Developer by default from the date of Notification. According to the Instruction, UACs may allow Developer/approved Co-Developers duty free goods and services for these default authorized operations from the date of Notification of the SEZ. These authorized operations will, however, continue to be subject to the various guidelines issued from Govt. from time to time. UACs while approving goods and services for such default operations may look into the actual requirements of the SEZ for such operations.

In the instant application, the infrastructure activities proposed by the Developer are covered in the consolidated list of default authorized operations that can be undertaken from the date of Notification of the SEZ circulated by the Ministry vide Instruction No. 50 and Instruction No. 54 (copies at Annexure).

With regard to the investment incurred in the project, the Developer has informed that out of the proposed investment of Rs. 199.54 crores, an investment of Rs. 163.87 crores has been made in the SEZ as on 30.09.2022. Further, the Approval Committee had earlier approved two separate lists of material for Rs. 88.40 crores and Rs. 45.60 crores out of which the Developer has procured material/goods of Rs. 54.94 crores and Rs. 34.18 crores, respectively, for its authorized operations. Therefore, as on 30.09.2022, there is an excess approval of Rs. 44.88 crores which the developer will not procure. The Developer has reasoned that initially they had applied for list of material for approval based on the projections and during implementation of the project certain specifications and design have been changed as there was long delay in the project due to Covid. As regards the construction activities completed so far, the Developer has informed that the building construction work has been completed and some landscaping work and interior work is under progress. The Developer has already started their own Unit on two floors in the SEZ and the rest of the space is available for business. Photographs of the site have also been submitted.

A copy of the list of materials required was also forwarded to the Specified Officer for his comment. The Specified Officer vide

	dated 23.11.2022 has informed that the material / items mentioned in the list submitted by the Developer appears to be the actual requirement by the Developer for their authorized operations and that the list of material / items has been duly approved by the Chartered Engineer and therefore may be approved.
	In view of the submissions and having regard to the laid down provisions in SEZ Rules, the proposal of the Developer is placed before the Approval Committee of the SEZ for consideration under Rule 12 read with Rule 10 of SEZ Rules, 2006 and Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 and Instruction No. 54 dated 30.04.2010 of Deptt. of Commerce.
Rule provision w.r.t SEZ Rules, 2006	In terms of Rule 12 of SEZ Rules 2006 read with Instruction No. 50 and 54, the Approval Committee may permit goods to carry on the authorized operations and in terms of Rule 12 the Developer can make application to the Development Commissioner along with list of goods and services including machinery, equipments and construction material required for the authorized operation duly certified by a Chartered Engineer for approval by the Approval Committee and the instant lists submitted by the Developer is duly certified by Authorized Signatory and the Chartered Engineer, along with a certification from an independent Chartered Engineer regarding requirement of the said materials for the proposed activities. Therefore, Rule 12 read Instruction No. 50 & 54 applies to the
	issue and thus the proposal is covered.
