Issue

Request for addition of items for the purpose of trading submitted by M/s Devshri Impex Pvt. Ltd. – LoA No. C-82/ISEZ/Proj./2012-13/729 dated 04.09.2012 – Broad-banding of LoA:-

M/s Devshri Impex Pvt. Ltd. is holding LoA No. C-82/ISEZ/Proj./2012-13/729 dated 04.09.2012 and is located at plot No. P-21 SEZ Phase II, Pithampur. The unit has been granted LoA for trading of Corrugated Boxes and accessories, Plastic Containers & closures' and for carrying warehouse service activities. The unit had acquired the SEZ unit by way change of entrepreneur by sale/transfer of SEZ unit under Rule 19 & 74A of SEZ Rules, 2006 in terms of the permission granted by the Approval Committee in its fourth meeting (2021-22 series) held on 14.09.2021. Pursuant to transfer, the Developer, MPIDC Ltd., RO, Indore has amended the lease deed of the afore-said plot and the deed registered on 06.12.2021. The unit has also executed a Bond-cum-Legal Undertaking amounting to Rs. 100.00 lacs pursuant to the approval for change of entrepreneur.

The unit has now submitted the captioned request for broad-banding of its LoA dated 04.09.2012 for addition of new items for

trading stating that they have been operating the unit since December 2021 and based on their study of the market demand and requirement they have learned that they need to expand their product list in order to cater to the pharmaceutical companies located within the SEZ. The unit has accordingly requested to include the following items for trading to be supplied to the pharmaceutical companies located within the SEZ:

- 1. Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Pharmaceuticals Packaging and its raw material like polypropylene, HDPE, LDPE, PET etc.
- 2. Stationary, printer ink, toner and consumables, lab equipments and regents for Pharma.
- 3. Disposables like Cap, mask apron, gloves, cotton etc.
- 4. Pharmaceuticals Active Pharma Ingredients, Bulk Drugs, Excipients and Pharma Chemicals.
- 5. Paper, Paper Boards and Paper products.
- 6. Cleaning Equipments, Regents, Chemicals and Antiseptic disinfectants for machine cleaning and housekeeping.
- 7. Adhensives and different type of tapes like BoPP etc.
- 8. Sanitary pads, Diapers, underpads etc. generally used for distribution under CSR activities.

The unit has submitted a project report for the proposed activities. As per the project report, the unit has proposed an investment of Rs. 18.00 lacs in addition to the existing investment of Rs. 38.65 lacs in the warehouse building along with a bank finance of Rs. 13.00 lacs for the trading activities. The existing share capital has been intimated as Rs. 1.00 lacs and promoters contribution as Rs. 58.00 lacs. The unit has proposed an export sale of Rs. 5.24 crores during the five year period from 2022-23 to 2026-27 for supplies to be made to the pharma units within the SEZ, foreign exchange outgo (CIF value of goods purchased) as Rs. 3.62 crores with NFE earning Rs. 1.62 crores.

Rule 76 of the SEZ Rules, 2006 provides for carrying out services by SEZ units for the purpose of clause (z) of section 2 of SEZ Act, 2005 and inter-alia includes Trading.

The proposal of the unit for inclusion of trading activities in the LoA dated 04.09.2012 is placed before the Approval Committee for consideration.

	MPIDC Ltd. Regional Office, Indore, Developer of Indore SEZ has submitted the captioned request for approval of the activity for Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of material required for 132 KV substation and equipments of determine voltage losses at Phase-I and II, Pithampur, Distt. Dhar (M.P.) and procurement of goods and services thereof through its contractor by the Approval Committee in terms of Rule 12 of SEZ Rules 2006 read with Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 of the Department of Commerce. The estimated cost of the proposed activity is Rs. 35.12 lacs.
	The Developer has informed that they have issued work order No. MPIDC/I/1577-81 dated 2.05.2022 to the appointed contractor M/s

Lavi Developers, Indore for the afore-said work to be carried out in SEZ Phase I and SEZ Phase II. The Developer has informed that the requisite activity is required to be done to ensure uninterrupted power supply to the SEZ units as batteries and electrical equipments are required to be replaced periodically.

Rule 12 of the SEZ Rules, 2006 stipulates that the Developer may import or procure goods and services from the DTA without payment of duty, taxes and cess for the authorized operations, subject to the provisions contained in the sub rules (2) to (8). Rule 12 (2), further states that the Developer shall make an application, after obtaining approval for the authorized operations under rule 9, to the Development Commissioner along with the list of goods and services, including machinery, equipments and construction materials required for the authorized operations, duly certified by a Chartered Engineer for approval by the Approval Committee. As per the provisions of Rule 10, the Approval Committee may permit goods and services to carry on the operations authorized under Rule 9 and second proviso to the subject rule provides interalia that exemptions, drawbacks and concessions on the goods and services allowed to the Developer shall also be available to the contractors including sub-contractors appointed by the Developer as per the provisions stipulated therein.

The Deptt. of Commerce has issued Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 circulating therein, a consolidated list of default authorized operations, which can be undertaken by the Developer/Co-Developer by default from the date of Notification. may the Instruction, UACs According Developer/approved Co-Developers duty free goods and services for these default authorized operations from the date of Notification of the SEZ. These authorized operations will, however, continue to be subject to the various guidelines issued from Govt. from time to time. UACs while approving goods and services for such default operations may look into the actual requirements of the SEZ for such operations.

In the consolidated list of default authorized operations under Instruction No. 50 dated 15.03.2010 which can be undertaken by the Developer/Co-Developer by default from the date of Notification, at S.No. A(4) of the instruction inter-alia the default authorized operation of 'Electrical, Gas and Petroleum Natural Gas Distribution Network including necessary sub-stations of appropriate capacity, pipeline network etc.' has been listed, and therefore the activity proposed by the Developer i.e. Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of material required for 132 KV substation and equipments of determine voltage losses at Phase-I and II, SEZ Pithampur falls within the aforementioned S.No. of the list of permitted default authorized operations. The
